ORDER

In the Government Order read as 3rd paper above, it was ordered that existing provisions in KER will continue to be in vogue (ie the age of admission to class I shall be five years for all the schools of the state) Kendriya Vidyalayas controlled by Government of India also switch over to age six as implied in the RTE Act. Several representations have since been received in Government requesting to clarify Government stand in the ensuing academic year.

Government, after having examined the matter are pleased to order that the statusquo of 5 years age for admission to class I maintained in all the schools of the state until further orders.
