ORDER

Age limit for recruitment of teachers has been fixed as 39 years vide GO read as 3rd paper above. Government have enhanced the age of compulsory retirement of Government Employees, Teachers and Staff of Aided Educational Institutions superannuating at the age of 55 to 56 years as per the GO read as 4th paper above. Consequent to this, as per GO read as 5th paper above, Government have enhanced the maximum age limit prescribed for direct recruitment to various categories of posts uniformly by one year. Various requests have been received in Government to extend this benefit to Aided School Teachers also.

Government have examined the matter in detail. Vide Rule 1(2) Chapter XIV (A) KER, the age limit and the relaxation thereof for appointment applicable to teachers of Government Schools shall apply mutatis mutandis to teachers of aided schools. In these circumstances, Government are pleased to clarify that the GO read as 5th paper above is applicable to Aided School Teachers also.
