**S. R. O. No. 953/2009.**—In exercise of the powers conferred under sub rule (1) of rule 3 in Chapter VI of the Kerala Education Rules, 1959, and in supersession of the Notification II issued under No. Ed. (C.SPL) 21564/59/EHD dated 8th June, 1959 and published in Kerala Gazette dated 9th June, 1959, the Government of Kerala hereby specify the authorities mentioned in column (2), against each categories of pupils mentioned in column (1), as the authorities for sanctioning alterations in the name, religion and date of birth of such categories of pupils, namely:—

<i>Categories of pupils</i>	<i>Authorities</i>
(1)	(2)
(i) Pupils studying in schools from Standards I to X.	Assistant Educational Officer/District Educational Officer having jurisdiction over the school in which the pupil is studying.
(ii) Pupils who have left schools before registering for S.S.L.C. Examination.	Assistant Educational Officer/District Educational Officer having jurisdiction over the school in which the pupil has studied.
(iii) Pupils who have registered for S.S.L.C. Examination.	Secretary to Commissioner for Government Examinations.

#### Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per the Notification II issued under No. Ed. (C.SPL) 21564/59/EHD dated 8-6-1959, published in the Gazette dated 9th June, 1959, as subsequently amended, District Educational Officers have been authorized to sanction alterations in the name and religion of pupils and the Commissioner for Government Examinations has been authorized to sanction alterations in the date of birth of pupils. As the number of pupils and schools have increased considerably, Office of the Secretary to Commissioner for Government Examinations cannot cope with the high volume of applications regarding alteration in school records. Hence, the Government have decided to authorize the District Educational Officers/Assistant Educational Officers to sanction alteration in school records in the name, religion and date of birth of pupils studying in Standard I to X or who left school before registering for SSLC Examination and the Secretary to Commissioner for Government Examinations in the case of pupils who have registered for SSLC Examinations.

The notification is intended to achieve the above purpose.
