Sth State Schools Athletic Meet 2014-2015

Instructions to Competitors Team Managers and Technical Officials

GENERAL

- 1. Utmost discipline and decorum becoming of a State Meet is expected from all districts participating in the meet. The stadium being situated in the heart of the town is extremely necessary that all persons should remain in their assigned places and avoid aimless wandering around.
- 2. The competitors will report at the Call Room, at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time. The team managers should send the athletes to the Call Room, with clearly pinned chest numbers at the front back side of the vest. Call Room Officials will direct the athletes to the competition arena, after verification of the chest Numbers.

TECHNICAL

- 1. 800 M race, heats final, will be conducted from a curved start.
- 2. Separate warming-up area is provided to the athletes. No athlete is permitted to do the "warming-up" inside the stadium.
- 3. All the athletes should return to the enclosure marked for athletes, immediately after the completion of their competition.
- 4. Entry to the main Pavilion is restricted to Officials and Invitees.
- 5. The team managers are advised to go through the detailed programme carefully and inform the errors, if any, soon after the registration. Any request for correction at the time of competition will not be entertained.
- 6. The allotments of Lanes and Orders of Competitions (Field events) are made by lot. In the subsequent rounds the lanes will be drawn separately according to their performance in the previous rounds.
- 7. Qualifying marks are fixed for all the field events (Horizontal Measurements) only those performances beyond the qualifying marks will be measured.
- 8. The team managers are requested to make sure that their wards are present for the victory ceremony in proper attire, when they are invited. (The Organizers are planning to hold the victory ceremony on the same day of the competition).
- 9. The Opening Ceremony will be held at LNCPE Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram at 3.30 pm on 08.12.2014 and all the participating teams are requested to report for the march past with their flags in the assembly area outside the stadium. Participants are requested to follow the instructions of Master of Ceremonies, as there will not be any rehearsal for the same.

Guest of honour is received by the President and members of the Organizing Committee at the entrance and escorted to the VIP Pavilion.

Assembly and March past of the athletes.

After the last event the teams assemble at the eastern side of the stadium. Captains carrying the flags will march on as the athletes enter the straight portion, the Chief Guest is escorted to the saluting based by the President, Secretary and the General Convener.

While passing the Rostrum the athletes pay their respects to the Chief Guest. The Captains will dip the flags forward. The athletes will assemble in front of the flag mast and sit on the ground.

The Director of Higher Secondary Education and Vice president of the Organizing Committee, requests the Chief Guest to distribute the Trophies and medals.

Sri. V.S. Sivakumar, the Hon'ble Minister for Health and Devaswom, distribute the Trophies and medals to winners-After the prize distribution all the athletes stand up. The Deputy Director, Physical Education and Sports, The Organizing Secretary requests the Guest of honour to declare the meet closed. The Chief Guest declare the meet closed with the following words.

"I declare the 58th Kerala State Schools Athletics Championship closed and call up on the school athletes of all districts to assemble next year at the appointed place to celebrate the 59th Kerala State Schools Athletics Championship. May the almighty help all, to display sustained cheerfulness, so that the message of sports could be carried on with ever greater eagerness, courage and honour for the good of humanity through out the ages".

Sri. M.D. Murali, Additional Director of Public Instruction (Academic) Propose vote of thanks. The President of the K.S.G.A. lowers the State School flag. Simultaneously all the district flags are lowered. Four athletes carry the State flag in slow march to the Chief Guest. The Chief Guest receives the flag and hands over the flag to the Secretary for safe custody till the next year with the following words.

"I deliver the flag to you for safe custody until such time, it is again flown at the next Kerala State Schools Athletics Championship".
